Elementary Bring From Home Items

Listed below are the items, by grade, students will need for the 2016-17 school year

Pre-Kindergarten

Please label each item with your child's name

- * Bath towel (or blanket of the same size) for rest time

Kindergarten

Please label each item with your child's name

- * 1 Box of at least 8 Crayons (Twistables preferred, no jumbo size)
- * Labeled towel for rest time
- * Labeled pencil box with name (8" x 5")
- * Labeled plastic-handled scissors, similar to Fiskar (blunt nose)
- * Labeled pink eraser
- * Ear Buds labeled and put in a Ziploc bag
- The following items do not need to be labeled:*
- * 4-6 Glue sticks
- * 1 Box of tissues
- * 1 Container of antibacterial wipes

Grade 1

Please label each item with your child's name

- * 4 black fine tip dry erase markers

Grade 2

- * 2 boxes of tissues (for the classroom)
- * 1 container antibacterial cleaning wipes (for cleaning desks after lunch)
- * 1 bottle hand sanitizer (for the classroom)
- * 1-pack #2 yellow pencils (will be shared by the class)
 - * Please purchase the Dixon Ticonderoga brand of pencils because the cheaper brands do not sharpen well.
- * 2 **small** glue sticks
- * 1 **small** box of crayons
- * 1 **small** box of markers
- * 1 pair of scissor (Fiskars are best)
- * 1 pack (4 count) **fine tip black** whiteboard markers
- * 1 large eraser
- * 1 red pen
- * 1 yellow highlighter
- * 1 pencil box (no bigger than 5 x 8 to fit inside desk)
- * 2 spiral notebooks (1 subject – wide ruled, 70 pages)
- * set of inexpensive ear buds (to be used only by your child)

Grade 3

Please label each item with your child's name

- * 3 (1/2 inch) 3-ring binder (No "Trappers" or Large binders)
- * Year's supply of notebook paper
(Not in a composition book or spiral; minimum of 2 reams suggested)
- * 1 box of 12 crayons
- * 1 box of (8 – 12) markers
- * 1 box of 12 colored pencils
- * 1 yellow or green highlighter
- * Year's supply of pencils
(Ticonderoga is a good quality name brand that I recommend.)
- * 1 or 2 large erasers
- * 1 glue stick
- * set of inexpensive ear buds (to be used only by your child)
- * 2 boxes of tissues
- * 1 (large) container of disinfectant wipes

Grade 4

Please label each item with your child's name

- * NO TRAPPER's, please.
Year's supply of notebook paper (Not in a composition book;
minimum of 2 packs suggested. Only bring one pack at start of
school.)
- * 1 box of crayons (12 or so is fine)
- * 1 box of markers (8 – 12 is fine)
- * 1 box of colored pencils (12 or so is fine)
- * 1 ballpoint pen (any bright color – red, green, purple, or orange)
- * Year's supply of pencils (At least 3 or 4 pencils should always be in desk.)
- * 1 or 2 large erasers
- * 1 glue stick or small bottle of glue
- * Scissors (Fiskars type – not rounded tips)
- * pencil box or pouch for keeping loose supplies
- * 1 pocket folder without prongs
- * 1 pocket folder with prongs
- * 2 boxes of tissues
- * 2 (large) containers of disinfectant wipes
- * set of inexpensive ear buds (to be used only by your child)
