**Music – Grades K-5**

- one folder with 3-ring prongs

**Computer – Grades K-5**

- one folder with 3-ring prongs
- headset/earbuds in a labeled Ziploc bag
  - please write students name on headset with permanent ink.

**Art Classes**

*The following are items the art room could use if parents would like to donate:*

- liquid dish soap
- erasers
- SOS pads
- masking tape
- Elmer's glue
- paint scrapers
- paper towels
- adult scissors
- duct tape
- broom
- sweep vac

**Kindergarten**

- one container of Germ-X hand sanitizer
  - one pack of Crayola markers
  - one pack of Crayola colored pencils
  - four sharpened pencils
  - six Elmers glue sticks
  - one round point, child-sized scissors
  - one 1" Five Star Flex Hybrid Notebinder, any color
  - two Mead Five Star plastic pocket folder, any color
  - three containers of Play-Doh
  - one pack of four low odor, thin dry erase markers
- \*\*no hand held pencil sharpeners, please\*\***

- one pencil pouch that fits in the 3-ring binder
- four boxes of 24 Crayola crayons
- one pair of headphones for computer class
- back pack that easily fits 3-ring binder
- one container of Lysol disinfectant wipes
- one box of tissues
- one box of gallon or sandwich size Ziploc bags
- one bottle of liquid hand soap
- one bottle of Elmers wet glue
- one package of sheet protectors

**First Grade**

- two thick dry erase markers
- two 12 packs of #2 pencils sharpened
- colored pencils and/or skinny (washable) markers
- crayons (no more than 24)
- one wide-ruled spiral notebook
- one bottle of hand sanitizer
- one box of tissues
- 4 large glue sticks
- one pack of disinfecting wipes (Lysol or Clorox)

- one medium/large eraser
- one pair of child scissors
- headset to use for listening station and computer lab
- one bottle of liquid hand soap
- one box of sandwich sized or gallon sized baggies

The following items should be labeled with your child's name:

- one 3-ring binder (1 inch) with two plastic sheet protectors
- three sturdy pocket folders with three hole punches
- pencil box that latches and fits in desk (no larger than 8 ½ x 11)

**Optional:**

- Bible (Zondervan Adventure Bible, NIV recommended)
- Extra pack of crayons, markers, dry erase markers, pencils or colored pencils to share with class

**Second Grade**

- at least six sharpened #2 pencils
- one glue stick
- one box of crayons (no more than 24)
- one large eraser
- one pack dry erase markers and one sock (for eraser)
- one pair of child scissors
- one pencil box
- six subject dividers with tabs  
(labeled as follows: spelling, math, history, science, writing, reading)
- four plastic pocket folders (student's name in upper right corner)
- one 3-ring binder (1 ½")

**\*Please be sure to label all of your child's school items with your child's name or initials.**

- grade 3 composition book (found at Staples)
- disinfecting wipes (Lysol or Clorox)
- one box of tissues
- The Adventure Bible NIV version by Zonderkidz
- headset in plastic Ziploc bag
- one composition book – wide ruled

Optional School Items:

- colored markers (washable)
- exercise ball to fit your child's size (45 cm may be best) not a large one
- one two gallon box of Ziploc bags
- extra pack of markers, dry erase markers, pencils to share with class

**Third Grade**

- school planner (please purchase at the school office before 1<sup>st</sup> day of school as they sell out quickly.)
  - one box of crayons or colored pencils
  - six pencils (not mechanical) for students pencil box
  - a small pencil box
  - one scissors
  - one container of Clorox wipes
  - four glue sticks
  - two large erasers
- \*\*no hand held pencil sharpeners, please\*\***

- one box of tissues
- two folders with pockets
- one pack of markers
- two spiral notebooks – all different colors
- one 1", 3-ring binder with pockets in the inside
- one set of tab dividers (should be five tabs, please do not write on them)
- two black Expo markers and old sock (to be used as an eraser)
- one box of gallon or sandwich size Ziploc bags

\*Optional: 1 New International Version Bible

\*Optional: 1 exercise ball for your child to use instead of a chair

If your child used an exercise ball last year, they may need a larger sized ball this year since they grew over the last year and the summer ☺

## **Fourth Grade**

- five subject dividers for binders
- one Duotang folder (3 prongs inside) – labeled Friday folder
- one 3-ring binder with clear front cover (at least 1 ½")
- two 3-hole double pocket folders with pockets at the bottom
- pencil bag for inside binder
- two erasers – labeled with name
- NIV Bible (labeled with name)
- HCS assignment book – we use it as a class  
(They sell out quickly, so please purchase one early)

- sharpened pencils – labeled with name
- one highlighter – labeled with name
- one package black Expo markers
- two boxes of tissues
- disinfecting wipes (Clorox)
- two blue pens
- one pack of notebook paper

## **Fifth Grade**

- one 2" or 3", three ring binder
- two highlighters
- pencils and erasers
- blue or black pens
- NIV Bible
- assignment book
- one yellow pocket folder with prongs
- one blue pocket folder with prongs
- one red pocket folder with prongs
- eight dry erase markers (low odor)\*
- one box of Ziploc sandwich or gallon bags

- one container of hand sanitizer\*
- one folder with pockets, that can go inside the binder
- five dividers for binder
- pencil bag that fits inside the binder
- one 1 subject spiral notebook
- two containers of disinfecting wipes (Clorox or Lysol)\*
- two boxes of tissues\*
- one roll of paper towels\*
- two hundred sheets of wide ruled notebook paper\*
- four glue sticks
- one box of plastic spoons\* (optional)
