Sixth Grade

- one large binder with dividers for each subject OR one 1" binder for each subject
 - red 1" binder (Language Arts)

- five folders with prongs in center (green, blue, purple, red, your choice)

Geometry

- Compass: Staedler "Geo Student" model recommended, or Staples generic similar model
- scientific calculator: must have trig functions (sin, cos, tan), TI-83 or better recommended (can be supplied by school if necessary)

Pre-Calculus & Calculus

- graphing calculator: TI-89 or TI-Nspire CX-CAS recommended

Bible 6, Bible 7 & Bible 8

- black journal
- HCSB Bible

English 7 & English 8

- English section in notebook or separate small notebook
- fine tipped colored pen for correcting/editing/punctuation
- highlighters (about 5) to highlight different parts of speech
- pocket folder (for writing portfolio)
- two book covers (if using book sox, get large)
- Notebook paper (either wide or college rule)
- Pencils and or blue or black pens
- one pack of Clorox wipes (**7th grade**)
- one pack of tissues (**8th grade**)

High School English

- Binder with notebook paper and pockets
- highlighter
- dry erase marker
- spiral or composition book
- pack of Post-it notes (Literature class)
- blue or black pen
- pencil and eraser
- a box of tissues OR a bottle of hand sanitizer OR a container of disinfecting wipes
- 2x5 notecards (writing class)
