

LM Flexible Instructional Day (FID) Plan

In order to improve the predictability of the school calendar and eliminate the need for make-up days throughout the spring and into June, LM follows a Flexible Instructional Day (FID) Plan. FIDs allow academic work to be completed at home when inclement weather requires closing the school building. FIDs will be counted as a school day since classes are still in session. There will be no live instruction (no Zoom), rather all learning will be asynchronous. LM will use up to five FIDs per school year.

High School (9-12th Grade)

- All teachers will post assignments on Schoology by 9:00 a.m. Each assignment should require no more than 30 minutes of time per class. Teachers may give additional homework as appropriate.
- Due dates and times will be posted by the teacher on Schoology. Assignments will be due no earlier than 4:00 p.m. on the FID.
- Teachers will check their email and Schoology accounts regularly throughout the day and be available for questions until 3:05 p.m.

Middle School (5-8th Grade)

- All teachers will post assignments on Schoology by 9:00 a.m. Each assignment should require approximately 15-20 minutes of time per class. Required work will total no more than 2.5 hours. Teachers may give additional homework as appropriate.
- Due dates and times will be posted by the teacher on Schoology. Assignments will be due no earlier than 4:00 p.m. on the FID.
- Teachers will check their email and Schoology accounts regularly throughout the day and be available for questions until 3:05 p.m.

Elementary School (PreK-4th Grade)

- Teachers will post the list of assignments at the top of the SeeSaw journal by 9:00am. Teachers may also send physical (hardcopy paper) assignments if the FID is known in advance. Required work will total no more than 2 hours, but additional learning options may be available.
- Assigned work should be easily accessible for students to complete as independently as possible.
- Students who have at-home learning codes for SeeSaw may also find assignments in their "Activities" tab on Seesaw, if the teacher indicates such.
- Assignments will be due the following school day.
- Teachers will check their email and SeeSaw accounts regularly throughout the day and be available for questions until 3:05 p.m.
