

## Pre-K Counts Information for Parents 2023-24

Lancaster Mennonite School offers Pre-K Counts (need-based) full scholarships, dependent on state funding. This grant is funded by the state as an initiative to have as many students as possible receive the opportunity to attend a quality Pre-K program. LM's program serves Pre-K students at our unified Lancaster Campus, 2176 Lincoln Hwy E, Lancaster, PA 17602.

## The qualifications to be considered for the Pre-K Counts grant include:

- Family income must be at or below 300% of poverty level (See chart below).
- The student must be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2023.
- The student must attend school full time (5 days a week).
- Additional considerations include risk factors such as English Language Learner, incarcerated parent, homelessness, teen mother, etc.

If you meet at least the first three qualifications listed above, you are invited to submit a Pre-K Counts Enrollment Form and submit your 2022 Federal Tax Return (pages 1 & 2 of 1040) to Erin Zuleta at Lancaster Mennonite School, 2176 Lincoln Highway East, Lancaster, PA 17602. Application does not guarantee acceptance for Pre-K Counts since there are limited slots.
