

Schoology Access Information

For middle school and high school we use an online service called **Schoology** (pronounced SCHOOL – uh - jee) to help teachers, parents, and students communicate regarding studies and other classroom activities, including grades.

With your unique parent/guardian username and password, you may view academic records for students. Other users cannot access your family's information.

Our goal in using Schoology is to increase communication between parents, students, and the school. By default, you will need to sign into Schoology in order to see your messages. If you want these messages forwarded to your email or phone you can:

Sign into your Schoology account as a parent
Select the pull-down arrow at the upper right corner of the screen next to your name
Select Settings
Select Notifications
Select the notifications of interest
