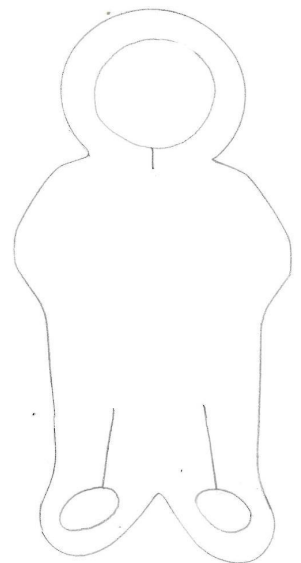


I can be a world changer by...
